1. Clinical Officers (100 posts)

The officers will be answerable to the in charge of the health facility concerned

Duties and responsibilities

- Clinical consultation and examination of patients
- Diagnosing and treating ailments at an outpatient department in a hospital of Health Centre
- Assist in planning and conducting primary health care activities
- Supervising and counselling staff engaged on routine patient care
- Giving support and health education to patients
- Provision of other services including comprehensive HIV/TB services
- Any other duties as may be assigned from time to time

Requirements

- Be a Kenyan citizen
- Be a holder of a Diploma in Clinical Medicine from a recognized institution
- Be registered by the Clinical Officers Council/valid practicing licence
- Must have a valid practicing licence
- Chapter six documents: Clearance from KRA, HELD, CID, CRB and EACC will be required at the time of interviews

Terms: 3 months Contract (Kshs. 30,000, consolidated pay)

2. Nurses (450 posts)

The officers will be answerable to the in charge of the health facility concerned

Duties and responsibilities

• Provide continuous, high level care to patients and their families

- Providing nursing services at various service delivery points
- Provision of other services including comprehensive HIV/TB services
- Implement and evaluate outcomes of care given to patients
- Any other duties as may be assigned from time to time by the supervisors

Requirements

- Be a Kenyan citizen
- Be a holder of a certificate/diploma in nursing
- Be registered by Nursing Council of Kenya/must have a practicing licence
- Must have a valid practicing licence
- Chapter six documents: Clearance from KRA, HELB, CID, CRB and EACC will be required at the time of interviews

Terms: 3 months Contract (Kshs. 30,000, consolidated pay)

3. Medical Laboratory Technologist: Job Group (50 Posts)

The officers will be answerable to the in charge of the health facility concerned

Duties and Responsibilities

Specific duties will include the following among others:

- Offering general diagnostic and specialized laboratory services in a medical laboratory
- Offering blood transfusion services
- Commodity management including rapid diagnostic kits
- Performing administrative duties including reporting
- Any other duties as may be assigned from time to time

Requirements

- Be Kenyan citizen
- Be a holder of a Diploma in Medical Laboratory Science from a recognized institution
- Be registered by the Kenya Medical Laboratory Technician and Technologist Board/Practicing Licence
- Must have a valid practicing licence
- Chapter six documents: Clearance from KRA, HELB, CID, CRB and EACC will be required at the time of interviews

Terms: 3 months contract (Kshs. 30,000, consolidated pay)

4. Medical Officers (JG 'M' 10)

- Clinical management of patients in department assigned; including clerking and admission of clients
- Clinical follow up of clients under care
- Assist the consultants in the execution of their duties including managing special outpatient clinics

- Head of the clinical team in the department assigned
- Conduct ward rounds
- Carry out procedures/interventions as may be appropriate
- Conduct specialty outpatient clinics
- Supervise and mentor other staff and students
- Any other duty as may be assigned from time to time by the supervisors

Requirements

- Be a Kenyan citizen
- Be a holder of a Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery from a recognized institution
- Be registered by the Kenya Medical Practitioners and Dentists Board
- Chapter six documents: clearance from KRA, HELD, CID, CRB and EACC will be required at the time of interviews

Terms: 3 months contract (Entry point of Job Group 'M')
